SUMMARY: Financial accounts of Benjamin Howe, physician of Whitefield, Maine. Most of entries record the sale of drugs, which are usually specified, and such services as bloodletting and house calls. The last page has a listing of births from December 1811 to April 1812 at which Howe attended.

Most of Howe's patients came from Whitefield or Alna, but Nobleboro, Dresden, and Jefferson are also represented.
