Columbia University School of Nursing Records, 1955-2013

COLUMBIA UNIVERSITY. SCHOOL OF NURSING. Records, 1955-2013. 5.6 cubic feet (14 boxes)

HISTORICAL NOTE: The School of Nursing was founded in 1892 by the Presbyterian Hospital Board of Managers as the Training School for Nurses. It became the Presbyterian Hospital School of Nursing in approximately 1904 and in 1928 moved with Presbyterian Hospital to the new Columbia-Presbyterian Medical Center in northern Manhattan.

Responsibility for the School's educational program was assumed by the Columbia University College of Physicians and Surgeons in 1935. This relationship was formalized in 1937 when the University established the Department of Nursing of the Faculty of Medicine, at which time the Director of the School became the Associate Dean for Nursing. However, most of the School's budget was still funded by Presbyterian Hospital which also continued to own and operate the School's physical plant. In 1974, the Dept. of Nursing became the Columbia University School of Nursing, though it remained part of the Faculty of Medicine, until 2000, at which time the Faculty of the Health Sciences was reorganized into the Faculties of Medicine, Dental and Oral Surgery, Nursing, and Public Health—in addition to the Faculty of Health Sciences—all headed by their respective deans.

The Nurse Anesthesia program was the first master's degree nurse anesthesia program in New York State and second in the United States. The Nurse Midwifery program is one of the oldest in the United States. In June 2004, the School first offered the Doctor of Nursing Practice (DrNP) degree.

Prior to 1970, only female students were enrolled in the School of Nursing.

Correspondence from Margaret Conrad (former Dean) as Chairman of the Alumni Distributing Fund Chairman, Alumnae Association of the School of Nursing of Presbyterian Hospital (1957-1956). Additional correspondence relating to the selection of "Class Agents" and medical center

fund. Contains letters from various alumnae, class of 1920, for 55th reunion in 1975. Also includes 55th reunion programs and other materials for the class of 1912 (1967). Programs and events generated by the School of Nursery, including alumni reunions, "Dean's Day," and pinning ceremonies, the bulk occurring the first or second Saturday in May. Printed programs created by the School of Nursing are open for research.

SERIES 2. COMMITTEE MINUTES

Minutes of School of Nursing committees, the bulk of which are from the Committee on Instruction, document critical decisions affecting administration, curriculum, faculty and student policies and procedures. Some may only include agendas rather than minutes. Has gaps and dates may overlap.

Includes self-evaluation study reports, course materials, and correspondence for the School as a whole and for specific degree programs, generated in the application process for accreditation and re-accreditation from the National League of Nursing, New York State Education Department, and the American Association of Nurse Anesthetists Council on Accreditation.

Early material includes syllabi and lecture notes (also clinical instruction notes) for the Nursing Course 45 and 46: Medical-Surgical Nursing (1962-1967). Later material includes teacher evaluations, student statistics, course descriptions and other information. Other specific programs documented include Nurse Anesthesia (1976-1985), Nurse Midwifery (1979-2003), and the Doctor of Nursing Science degree (2003-2005).

Some reports are bound in oversized binders.

CLOSED RECORDS: Series 3: Faculty manual, 1996-2005 (Box 6, folders 4-7; Box 7, folder 1) are closed for 25 years from creation. They are open in 2022-2031.

Series 4: Two reports: "Doctor of Nursing Practice report, 2005" and NYSED: "Re-accreditation and Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education reports, 2003 are closed for 25 years from creation. They are not open for research until 2031 and 2029, respectively.

The report: "Doctor of Nursing Science program review, 2003" contains student or applicant test scores, so is not open until 2079.

LANGUAGE: English.

ACCESS: All university administrative records, excluding printed material, are closed for 25 years from date of creation.

Records identified in the folder list as containing confidential student information are closed for 75 years from date of creation.

PROVENANCE: Transfer from the School of Nursing, 2017 (accessions #2017.010, #2017.017).
