SUSSER, MERVYN, 1921-2014.

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE: Mervyn Susser, physician, epidemiologist, and public health activist was born in Johannesburg, South Africa, on Sept. 26, 1921, son of Solomon and Ida Rose (née Son) Susser. The family later moved to Mokopane in Limpopo Province, where his parents ran a hotel and a store near a tin mine.

Susser graduated from Durban High School and attended University of the Witwatersrand for a year before voluntarily enlisting in the military for service during World War II. He returned to Witwatersrand in 1945 where he was awarded the medical degree in 1950. Susser and his wife Dr. Zena Stein, whom he married in 1949, then joined the staff of the Alexandra Health Centre and University Clinic, located in a poor township outside Johannesburg. However, their growing involvement in the anti-apartheid movement led to their dismissal from the clinic in 1955. The next year he and Stein departed for political reasons, immigrating to Great Britain where Susser became a member of the Dept. of Social and Preventive Medicine at Manchester University and Medical Officer for the city of Salford.

In 1966, Susser was named chairman of the Division of Epidemiology at the Columbia University School of Public Health (now the Mailman School of Public Health) which he led until 1978. He became founding Director of the Gertrude H. Sergievsky Center as well as the first Gertrude H. Sergievsky Professor of Epidemiology in 1977. Susser led the Center, devoted to interdisciplinary research in epilepsy and other developmental disorders of the nervous system, until 1991 at which point he was named professor emeritus. Susser had an active retirement, publishing widely, participating in numerous professional committees, and serving as the editor of the *American Journal of Public Health* from 1992-1998.

Susser's professional interests were wide-ranging. He did important work on peptic ulcers in Europe; the effect of infant malnutrition on human development; HIV and AIDS in the United States and South Africa; and the conceptual basis of epidemiology. He published extensively; notable works include *Medical Care in a South African Township* (1955), with Stein; *Sociology in Medicine* (1st. ed., 1962) with anthropologist William Watson; *Causal Thinking in the Health Sciences: Concepts and Strategies of Epidemiology* (1973), and *Famine and Human Development: The Dutch Hunger Winter of 1944/45*, with Stein and others in 1975.

He and Stein remained politically engaged in the struggle for human rights in South Africa. Susser was among the founding members of the Committee for Health in

Southern Africa (CHISA) and was active in the American Public Health Association's International Human Rights Committee.

Susser died in Hastings-on-Hudson, N.Y., on August 14, 2014 and was survived by his wife, Zena Stein; three children; and several grandchildren.

SCOPE & CONTENT: Correspondence, reprints, reports, notes, conference papers and other materials documenting Susser's career in epidemiology and public health over four decades. There is little material relating to his personal life though there are several memoirs and reminiscences.

ARRANGEMENT/ORGANIZATION: The collection has been organized into five series: I. Early Correspondence; II. Later Correspondence; III. Publications; IV Professional Activities; V. Committees.

SERIES I. EARLY CORRESPONDENCE

BOX 1-8

Departmental and individual correspondence on a broad variety of topics. Subseries are as follows:

Sub-series 1.1: Division of Epidemiology chronological correspondence (6 folders)

Columbia University Division of Epidemiology correspondence, arranged chronologically, 1973-1975 (incomplete).

Sub-series 1.2: General correspondence (8 boxes, 2.66 cu. feet)

Correspondence with professional colleagues, dating from the mid-1960s to the late 1970s. It is incomplete, only starting with surnames beginning with "Go." There is some chronological overlap with Series II Later Correspondence with correspondence from the same individual sometimes appearing in both series.

SERIES II. LATER CORRESPONDENCE (43 boxes, 14.33 cu. feet)

BOX 8-51

Correspondence with professional colleagues dating from the mid-1970s to the early 21st century. There is some chronological overlap with Series I Early Correspondence with correspondence from the same individual sometimes appearing in both series.

Topics documented include the American Public Health Association's Human Rights Committee, including reports and publications; Aesculapius International Medicine organization; Alexandra Township, South Africa, and the Kark movement; Center for Epidemiological Research in South Africa; travel to assorted foreign countries, including South Africa and El Salvador; HIV research; materials designated by Susser as "memoirs and honors;" the Institute of Medicine; National Academy of Science Food and Nutrition Board; the long-term health impact of the Three Mile Island nuclear power plant accident; and the National Research Council's Subcommittee on Vitamin A Deficiency Prevention and Control.

Susser also sometimes filed correspondence and other documents with his records on articles, conferences, lectures. Researchers should also be sure to check these materials in Series III and IV.

SERIES III. PUBLICATIONS

BOX 51-67

Articles, book chapters, and other publications authored by Susser. Besides a copy of the publication, these records may also include correspondence with co-authors and editors, drafts, and background materials. Subseries are as follows:

Sub-series 3.1: Articles with p-numbers (7 boxes, 2.33 cu. feet)

Copies of articles, in "P-Number" order, to correspond with works listed on his CV.

Sub-series 3.1: Articles without p-numbers (3 boxes, 1 cu. feet)

Articles not assigned P-numbers, arranged chronologically.

Sub-series 3.2: Book Chapters, with PB Numbers (2 boxes, .66 cu. feet)

Copies of book chapters, assigned "PB" [paper to book] numbers, to correspond with Susser's CV, arranged in PB-number order.

Sub-series 3.3: Book chapters without PB numbers (7 folders)

Book chapters not assigned numbers, arranged chronologically.

Sub-series 3.4: Miscellaneous Publications (1 box, .33 cu. feet)

Reports on mental health services in Salford, England; copies of two books written by Susser; correspondence related to other publications; arranged chronologically.

Sub-series 3.5 Psychiatric Disorders (4 folders)

Articles on developing and implementing a community mental health service.

Correspondence, brochures, notes, finished papers and other materials documenting Susser's professional activities. Arranged in sub-series created by Susser, and then chronologically.

Sub-series 4.1: Conferences (6 boxes, 2 cu. feet)

Correspondence and other materials from conferences attended by Susser; arranged chronologically.

Sub-series 4.2: Conference papers (2.5 boxes, .66 feet)

Copies of papers, notes, correspondence and other records related to conference papers presented by Susser; arranged chronologically.

Sub-series 4.3: Invited lectures (8 folders)

Copies of papers, notes, correspondence and other records related to lectures which Susser was invited to present; arranged chronologically.

Sub-series 4.4: Lecture notes (1 box, .33 cu. feet)

Lectures notes and texts, arranged chronologically

Sub-series 4.5: Miscellaneous lectures (5 folders)

Lectures on a variety of topics, including the epidemiology of mental retardation, services for disabled and retarded children, and community care of the mentally ill.
